Work Desk

- A.1.1.** All desks are equipped with a **support frame made of painted steel profile with a rectangular cross-section**, measuring **20 × 40 × 2 mm**.
- A.1.2.** The vertical supports are internally manufactured from a **30 × 30 mm steel tube**, which is externally clad with **MDF faced with natural wood veneer**. The veneered leg is **finished with a clear varnish**, providing a durable and aesthetically uniform surface.
- A.1.3.** The connection joints between the vertical and horizontal frame elements are manufactured from **die-cast aluminium**, finished with **electrostatic powder coating**, ensuring strength and stability at the frame connections.
- A.1.4.** The worktops have a **thickness of 18 mm** and are manufactured from **three-layer particleboard, emission class E0.5**, with **double-sided melamine coating**. The perimeter edges are fitted with **2 mm-thick edge banding**, providing enhanced edge protection and improved resistance to everyday use.
- A.1.5.** All desk types are equipped with **levelling adjusters with a height adjustment range of 0–25 mm**, allowing precise levelling and adaptation of the desk to uneven floor surfaces.
- A.1.6.** All desk types can be equipped with **18 mm-thick modesty panels**, manufactured from **E0.5 particleboard with melamine coating**. They can additionally be fitted with **cable management channels and cable outlet grommets**, providing efficient and organised management of electrical and data cabling.
